All the students are hereby informed that "Post Matric Scholarship" "Gagan Bharari Shiksha Yojana" and "Merit Based Award" for the year 2021-2022 for SCHEDULED TRIBE students is announced by Directorate of Tribal Welfare, Panaji-Goa. All students are required to collect Form from Mrs. Nisha Kharangate, UDC in the office and submit the filled in form along with the following documents.

1. Passport Size Photograph
2. Attested copies of Mark sheet/Passing Certificate of the exam passed in the Academic year 2020-2021.
3. Attested copy of Income Certificate issued by competent authority for the year 2020-21
4. Attested copy of Scheduled Tribe certificate issued by competent authority.
5. Attested copies of hostel receipts.
6. Attested copies of Fees payment receipts
7. Attested Copy of Bank Pass Book
8. Attested Copy of Aadhaar Card.

1. **Income Ceiling for claiming Post Matric Scholarship** - Family income of the student should not exceed **Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand only) per Annum.**
2. **Income Ceiling for claiming Gagan Bharari Shiksha Yojana** - Family Income should not exceed **Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh) per Annum.**
3. **Income Ceiling for claiming Merit Based Award** - Family Income should not exceed **Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs) per Annum.** Student should secure the requisite bench mark percentage of 50% and above.

The students applying under Post Matric Scholarship Scheme should open a Saving Bank Account in any Nationalized Bank in the Vicinity of Educational Institution as the amount of scholarship will be directly credited to the Bank Account of the student.

Interested students should submit their application to Mrs. Nisha Kharangate, UDC latest by 12/11/2021.
