NOTIFICATION

Government of Goa has approved the implementation of Diamond Jubiler:
Government Investment for Technical Education Scheme (DJ-GIFT Education Scheme) to incentivise students' encolment in Technical Degree/Diploma Institutions in the State of Goa.

DIAMOND JUBILEE - GOVERNMENT INVESTMENT FOR TECHNICAL EDUCATION SCHEME

1. Short title and commencement:-

- 1.1. This Scheme shall be titled as "Diamond Jubilee-Government Investment For Technical Education Scheme", or in short, "DJ-GIFT Education Scheme".
- 1.2. The scheme shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette

2. Objectives of the Scheme:

- 2.1 Technical Education contributes significantly to the socio-economic growth and development of the State Recognizing the fact that higher fees charged for technical education courses in comparison to general courses could be a major factor dissuading capable, eligible students from pursuing technical education courses, thereby leading to a declining trend in students seeking admissions to technical courses.
- 2.2 In view of the above, the Government seeks to partially alleviate this financial burden on students and their parents; by way of providing financial assistance towards fees payable for technical education courses.
- 2.3 The financial assistance provided under the scheme shall encourage and facilitate more Goan students to enroll and avail technical education and training, thereby enhancing their employment potential, and consequent contribution to the State economy

3. Details of the Scheme:

- 3.1 The beneficiaries will pay a Base Fee, to be notified by the Directorate of Technical Education from time to time. The Government will bear the amount equal to sum of Tuition Fee & Development Fee minus the Base Fees.
- 3.2 The Base Fee shall be rightfied for a batch to be admitted in each licademic year. The Base Fee, once fixed, shall remain the same for the entire duration of the Programme/ Course enrolled for, by the students of that batch.
- 3.3 Base Fee will be reviewed and revised by the Government for each admission batch year, and notified at the time of admission.

- 3.4 In addition to the Base Fee, admitted students need to pay all other fees, as applicable except Tuition fees and Development Fees.
- 3.5 Payable amount will be directly released to the private institutions listed at para 4 of this scheme, at the time of admissions, and thereafter, at the beginning of every semester
- 4. To be eligible under this scheme.-
- 4.1 a student should be admitted under General, SC, ST, OBC, PWD, FWS, FF categories and management quota seats, as per the prospectus for admissions, issued by Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Goa
- 4.2 a student should be enrolled for Technical Degree/Diploma courses in the following institutions in the State of Goa, from the academic year 2021-22:

- 5. Commencement and Duration of the Scheme:
- 5.1 To incentivise the enrolment in Technical courses, the Scheme shall be applicable to all the eligible students enrolled in the above listed technical institutions (Degree/Diploma) in the State of Goa, from the academic year 2021-2022
- 5.2 The scheme shall be implemented for 04 (Four) years.

SUB: Procedure and rules for availing benefits under DJ-GIFT Scheme .

- Students enrolled in Graduate Degree and Diploma programmes in the 15 AICTE approved Degree and Diploma institutions in the State of Goa, as notified in the Scheme, are eligible to avail the Scheme, from year 2021-22.
- Students admitted to the notified institutions in the following categories are eligible to avail the scheme:
 General, SC, ST, OBC, EWS, PWD, FF, Management Quota.
- Management Quota students shall fulfil the requirements of General Category candidates, as specified in the common prospectus for admissions, issued by Directorate of Technical Education, for availing the Scheme.
- Admitted students shall pay Base Fee, as notified by the Government, for the batch admitted in each academic year.
- In addition, admitted students shall pay all other fees, as applicable, except Tuition Fee and Development Fee.
- Since the Scheme is commencing in 2021-22, the Base Fee notified for 2021-22 shall be applicable to all students enrolled in 2021-22, including those admitted in earlier years.
- 7. Eligible students who wish to avail benefits under the Scheme shall submit an application, in prescribed proforma, through the Principal of the institution, where he/she is admitted/enrolled, along with required documents: Base Fee payment receipt, category, any other specified document/s.
- 8. In case of students admitted in earlier years, required to pay applicable fees lesser than the Base fee notified for 2021-22, they shall pay the applicable fee, as notified for the earlier admission batch year.
- Lateral Degree admission students shall be entitled to avail the Scheme, only if they have passed their qualifying Diploma exam from BTE, Goa.

- Lateral Diploma admission students shall be entitled to avail the Scheme, only if they have passed their Higher Secondary/Vocational exam from institutions in the State of Goa.
- Students shall be eligible to avail the Scheme only for minimum course duration. Any student who is covered under the Scheme, failing to keep terms satisfactorily, and/or does not appear for term/semester/year end examination, shall not be eligible to claim any further benefits under the Scheme.
- 12. Students availing benefit under any other free ship or scholarship scheme of the State Government/Central Government/other Organizations shall not be entitled to avail the benefits of this Scheme.
- 13. Private, self Financing institutions shall, as per proforma to be prescribed, furnish full details of the students enrolled, to the Directorate of Technical Education, along with the Base Fee paid, certifying the Fee liability to be released.
- DTE reserves the right to carry out inspections of the self financing institutions for verification of the relavant data submitted.
- 15. DTE reserves the right to add, modify, amend, review, revise any or all of the above rules for smooth implementation of the Scheme, ensuring that the objectives of the Scheme are fulfilled.
